

How do you want your next holiday to be? Take a look at the following pages and start planning your own adventure. Berti and all of us at Bareiss are looking forward to seeing you.



THE PETTING ZOO

Three cheeky ponies, playful dwarf goats and a growing family of bunnies, that is the colourful gang of little rascals who are at home at our Bareiss Petting Zoo. They are all very tame and curious but they do also have a mind of their own. And that is a good thing as it tells you very quickly whether they are feeling well or whether they are not happy with something.

You know that you should always be careful when dealing with animals and approach them gently so as to avoid scaring them. It is no secret either that they like to nibble at everything which appears in front of their noses. And they know no limits of their own when eating. Feeding them in-between is not a very good idea. So we will do this together.

Bea, Bibiana and Bless, the classic ponies, seem to be the spitting images of each other at first glance. But when you are here, we will reveal you the secret of how you can tell them apart.

Our bunnies are all little »rascals« and know how to rope others in. When they come closer to you, this shows that they are curious. The best idea is to first allow them to sniff the palm of your hand.

Our West African Dwarf Goats are the smallest breed of goats in the world. Plants grow rather sparsely and the climate is dry in their home countries. In the wilderness, they have to cope with this on their own and that's why they are such undemanding and compact animals.

THE BAREISS ANIMAL WORLD FOR YOU!

Watch, approach, and sharpen your senses animals are simply fascinating and are a true gift to us humans. We can learn so much by spending time with them. Did you know that horses are highly attuned to your feelings and can mirror your behaviour? That rabbits are prey animals and can move their ears independently in all directions? Or that in a goat herd, every member has a role, and those who don't follow the rules get into trouble?

Animals meet us without prejudice. How they organise themselves within their groups and communicate without words is something you can observe not only in our petting zoo but also in the fallow deer herd, the beehives at Morlokhof, and at the Forellenhof Buhlbach. Plus, there's now a feeding station at the fish pond in the Forest Park, where you can help feed the fish. The daily ration is carefully measured - once the box is empty, please come back another time.



and every time we go there together

Fallow deer have a sociable character and like being in large herds. However, the stags and females move out in separate groups outside the mating season. They are rather shy and use their eyes, ears and nose to spot any danger in plenty of time. You can tell what mood they are in by their tail: If it is hanging down loosely or wagging a little, everything is fine. If they sense danger, it will be horizontal - and if they are on the run, it will point upwards. When they are running from danger you will see them doing so-called bounce jumps, in which they take off from the ground with all four legs at the same time. They do this to demonstrate their strength in order to drive away any predators.

BEEKEEPING

From May to September, you can take a closer look at our bees - and maybe even see them swarming if you're lucky! In a bee colony, each bee has its own special role. The queen is the only fertile female; she goes on a nuptial flight with the drones and lays the eggs. Afterwards she is looked after by an army of perfectly organised workers so that she can concentrate fully on her task. Amongst the workers there are cleaners, nurses, maids, guards, heaters, aerators, scouts, collectors - yes, and even an alarm standby reserve. It's no wonder that beehives are buzzing with activity.

THE FORELLENHOF

What do fish like? In which environment do they feel most comfortable? How can we make sure that herons don't catch them? In our trout farm, you can find out first-hand what rainbow trout, salmon trout, golden trout and char need in order to flourish. Our fish farmers will take you on a tour of the facilities and show you how the flow channel basin, hatchery, technical building and filter systems work. It's not so much about the fishing as it is about the fish themselves. You can learn how to distinguish between different species, find out where they get their names from and why trout don't like »lazing around«.






THE BAREISS »REITERHÖFLE«

We also go on outings together, including family hacks to the Sattelei hiking lodge or other beautiful spots in the area.



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


TABLE TENNIS


TIME TO PLAY





BLACK REDSTART

The Black Redstart is the »Bird of the Year 2025«, taking over the spot from the Lapwing of 2024. It is active even before dawn and is the first to sing in the morning. The Long-eared Owl and Black Woodpecker took second and third place, followed by the Black Stork and Crane.



Some birds build the nests outdoors while others prefer moving into a perfect home. Ask one of our nesting box professionals to show you how to build a perfect house for a bird family. Why do toads migrate? You can learn the answer to this question and many other things during a walk with Hermann Rastetter, our forester, who is active in campaigns for these amphibians, and likes to tell you something about them.



If you are interested in plants and animals, or just feel incredibly happy when you roam through woodlands, our Black Forest is the perfect place for you. Light, sounds, smells and just about everything changes as soon as you step into this pristine wilderness. If you keep your eyes, ears and nose open, nature will reward you with fascinating little wonders. If you want to know what it's like underground or high up in the treetops, you should definitely plan a visit to our National Park Centre. A fascinating experience awaits you here, immerse yourself in the forest wilderness and - thanks to computer animation - you can experience what's it like to glide over the national park with a falcon.





HUMMINGBIRD HAWK-MOTH

This beautiful moth can be recognised by its flight pattern and the two-part tuft of hair on its abdomen, which resembles the tail feathers of a pigeon. Its hovering mode of flight, similar to that of a hummingbird, has earned it the nickname »Hummingbird Moth«. Interestingly, it is a active during the day despite the moth being a nocturnal species.



STAG BEETLE

This beetle is only 14 to 20 millimetres long, so one might wonder how it got its Latin name, »Typhaeus typhoeus«, referring to a giant with 100 dragon heads from Greek mythology. The English name refers to a stag with »antlers« with which the male beetles defend their nest against rivals.

SPARROW OWL

The Sparrow Owl is the smallest owl in europe, measuring around 19 centimetres, making it a true dwarf among its kind. It is native to the Black Forest but is rarely seen due to its very shy nature. However, don't underestimate it: this tiny owl can pose a threat to thrushes.



You are fascinated by birds of prey, and admire their acrobatic flight manoeuvres? Do you also know how to identify a buzzard, a red kite and a hawk? If so, you will have a great time with our expert Achim Klumpp, and, with a little luck, he will also take you to a rescue centre if an animal happens to be there for feeding up.








ADVENTURE GOLF

FREUDENSTADT CITY RALLY



TRAVELLING ON YOUR OWN



E-BIKE RENTAL



Make your way into the deep thicket, descend into the earth, and feel like a beetle yourself: At the Ruhestein National Park Centre, the forest becomes its own storyteller, and invites you to a multimedia meet-up with the animal and plant kingdoms.



Making butter, weaving baskets, or binding brushwood bind, this open-air museum located in Gutach brings back farm life as it used to be 600 years ago as »Menne«, the museum's mascot playfully introduces you to an exciting past. History you can touch, not covered in dust by any means.



The Lothar Trail in Baiersbronn takes you over footbridges, ladders and stairs through a wild forest area swept down by the gusts of Cyclone Lothar.

Nobody has come here to tidy this up as nature is regenerating itself, leading to the stunning results you can see today.



Murgtal Arena in Forbach and overcome the dreaded »kayak roller«, the most turbulent water vortex on this stretch of the river. Anyone who stays dry in the process has clearly cheated. So be sure to carry a towel and spare clothes.



UNIMOG MUSEUM

The Unimog Museum in Gaggenau is a great transport and technology museum which is really second to none. You can gaze at an impressive parade of four-wheeled all-terrain juggernauts, have a look under their bonnets and learn everything about their technology.

Out into the snow!






Berti's Energy Bear Bars

150 g honey | 150 g peanut butter | 1tsp cinnamon | 200 g oats | 100 g sunflower seeds | 100 g peanuts | 100 g desiccated coconut | a pinch of salt

Preheat the oven to 100 °C (fan) or 120 °C (top/bottom heat). Heat the honey, peanut butter, and cinnamon in a pot on the stove, allowing them to melt. Stir in the remaining ingredients. Line a baking tray with parchment paper, spread the mixture evenly on top, and dry it in the hot oven for one hour. Remove from the oven, allow to cool, and cut into bars or break into pieces.

YOU WILL NEED:

Glue and Scissor

- **1.** Cut out all the pieces.
 Glue the ends of the long strips at a right angle to each other. Now, fold a Jacob's ladder by folding the bottom strip over the top one until only the small ends remain. Glue these together and cut a straight edge with scissors.
- **2.** Glue two legs, one on front and one on the back, next to each other below into the Jacob's ladder.
- **3.** Fold the horse's neck along the crease line. Glue one tab to the horse's head and attach the other tab to the front of the witch's ladder. Fold the tail along the crease line and glue the tabs at the other end of the witch's ladder.
